More Information...

- ◆ All new patients are asked to bring proof of income (paystub, 1040, W-2, etc.) , a list of current medications, and any medical records obtained from previous doctors.
- ◆ Patients are not charged but a \$5.00 donation is requested as each visit.
- ◆ The Fountain Clinic is a non-profit organization founded in 1992.
- ◆ The clinic receives no government assistance; we are able to operate with the help of grants as well as monetary donations and the generous donation of supplies.
- ◆ The clinic is closed for lunch from noon -1pm and will occasionally close for meetings.

What Services Do We Provide?

- ◆ Physician Clinics, staffed by volunteer physicians and physician assistants, are held 2-4 days each week.
- ◆ A Registered Nurse is on site 5 days a week
- ◆ Assistance with the Affordable Health Care Act and signing up for insurance.
- ◆ Labs & x-rays ordered by the Clinic's volunteer physicians are mainly covered by a grant from Oaklawn Hospital.
- ◆ Prescription assistance & dental assistance is provided to senior citizens 60 years and older who meet Calhoun County Senior Millage guidelines.
- ◆ Patients needing help with prescriptions may be eligible for assistance through pharmaceutical companies' programs.
- ◆ The Fountain Clinic DOES NOT cover any hospital charges.
- ◆ The Fountain Clinic is not a pharmacy. Prescriptions are only provided to Fountain Clinic patients or Patient Assistance Programs. *Controlled substances will not be prescribed or dispensed.*
- ◆ Optical referrals are available for anyone in the Marshall area or anyone with a letter from the Albion Lion's Club.
- ◆ \$5.00 Dental Cleanings & Screenings for low income uninsured.
- ◆ Psychological Services and counseling is available to Fountain Clinic patients one day per week.
